A Few of the Benefits from having Correct Theology

• The True Knowledge of God

My son, if you will receive my words And treasure my commandments within you, ... Then you will discern the fear of the Lord And discover the knowledge of God. (Pr 2:1,6, NAS)

• Abundant Life

Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord; seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him ... (2 Peter 1:2-4, NASB)

• Stability

Without correct beliefs a person never knows what is absolute, and thus has instability. As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming; (Eph 4:14, NASB)

This is especially important today:

... preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths. (2 Tim 4:2-4, NASB)

• Freedom

Bondage comes from believing lies. Believing truth sets you free.

"If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free." (Jn 8:31-32, NASB)

The Desperate Need for Doctrine

I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all handed down to the saints. (Jude 3-4, NASB)

For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 1:5-8, NASB)
