

## Cost

The cost is greatly reduced to provide the equivalency of a Bible College training at an affordable price. Each 3-hour course is \$300. Additional costs include registration fees, and course materials.

## Auditing Courses

Students may audit courses without having to do any assignments. However, no credits will be earned. A \$100 fee will still be required.

## Statement on Accreditation

Neither O.N.E. School nor ADVANCE is a regionally or ATS accredited program. Gateway Seminary professors have provided course descriptions, learning objectives, and example syllabi. Course content is supervised by the ADVANCE National Office to ensure high standards. However, classes are post high school, not Master's level. #### • Parents

Parents have the wonderful privilege and awesome responsibility to teach their kids.

*"These words, which I am commanding you today,  
shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently  
to your sons"* (Deut 6:6-7, NASB)

## Other Possible Courses in the Spring

Do you or someone you know have an interest in two possible class offerings?

The first class would be regarding **Church Revitalization**. The subjects covered in the class are designed to get a better understanding of culture, contextualization, and communication and how they impact the change process. We would also study the important parts of leading a church through a healthy change process. One of the required textbooks would be *From Embers to a Flame* by Harry Reeder. The other textbooks have not been chosen yet.

The second class would be **Basic Biblical Greek I** class. This is a beginning level class and will help the student begin to have a working knowledge of Greek vocabulary and grammar. The required textbook and corresponding workbook are *Basics of Biblical Greek Grammar*, 4th edition, and its workbook. *Biblical Greek I* would be completed over two semesters.

Each class would need at least three people committed to attending weekly for the fifteen-week semester. The class will meet once a week for three hours.
